

Old Rhinebeck Aerodrome Jim Hare Memorial Scholarship

Jim Hare was a longtime employee of The Old Rhinebeck Aerodrome and he spent his life as the museum's greatest advocate, primary announcer and cheerleader. His personality was infectious and he was a friend to all. He had a passion for vintage aviation and music. His family and his Aerodrome family meant the world to him. He was an active volunteer in his community and his zest for life was contagious. This \$500 scholarship is funded by the generosity of Rhinebeck Aerodrome volunteers, friends of Jim and the Board of Trustees. The scholarship will be presented to the winner at The Spirit of the Aerodrome Gala on May 18th.

To be eligible students must:

1. Be a graduating senior from a High School in Dutchess County.
2. Have been an active participant in the culture of their school and/or community.
3. Has been accepted to a two, or four year college, or recognized field of post-secondary study.
4. Complete the attached questions and submit a short personal statement of no more than two paragraphs reflecting on the personal statement guidelines.
